COMMUNITY UPDATE

<u>ASB</u>

In the last month we have issued 7 Unacceptable Behaviour Warning Letters' (UBWL's) in the Spilsby area. These have been issued by East Lindsey District Council with the support of South Wolds officers and relate to reports of ASB causing harassment, alarm, or distress to members of the public. Further UBWL's have been issued throughout the South Wolds area.

On Thursday the 11th of May, enquiries led us to an address in Swaby that had been converted into a large cannabis grow. A male fled the scene but was arrested, charged, remanded, and put before the court. Any information about drugs can be reported anonymously to Crimestoppers.

On the evening of 05/06/23 our patrols stopped three people in Horncastle. They were searched under the misuse of drugs act and were arrested after drugs were found.

Traffic Offence

On 0/05/23 officer stopped a car in Partney area. The driver was found not to have insurance. They will be prosecuted, and their car has been seized.

On 04/05/23 officer stopped a car in South Thoresby area. The driver was found not to have insurance. They will be prosecuted, and their car has been seized.

On 05/05/23 our officers stopped a vehicle travelling in Partney. The driver was found to be disqualify and

have no insurance. They will be persecuted, and the car has been seized.

On 11/05/23 Our patrols stopped a car in the Spilsby area. Inquiries revealed that the driver had no Insurance. The car was seized, and the driver will be prosecuted.

On 18/05/23 our patrols stopped a car in Wragby. The driver was found not to have insurance or a driving licence. They will be prosecuted, and their car has been seized.

Frauds and Scams:

We have made combating scams one of our divisional priorities as we have seen an increase in this type of crime being reported since January 2023. CID are investigating crimes where offenders have targeted victims by claiming to be police officers. The offenders then ask the victim to transfer money from their bank account, purchase items online or withdraw cash. The fraudsters will later attend the victims home address and collect the cash, this is sometimes referred to as courier fraud. Please remember your bank or the police will **NEVER**:

- 1. Phone and ask for your PIN or banking password
- 2. Ask you to withdraw money
- 3. Ask you to transfer money to a new or other account for fraud reasons, even if they say it is in your name
- 4. Send someone to your home to collect cash, PIN, cards, or cheque books if they say you have been a victim of fraud
- 5. Ask you to purchase goods using your card and then hand them over for safe keeping.
