
Hundleby Parish Rooms Development Survey Results 2022


Q1 What benefit would an upgraded and modernised village hall have for you and your family





Summary of Results

- 34% of the surveys circulated were returned. That is 113 of the 330 surveys given out. That is an excellent result and very helpful.
- 75% of respondents were from Hundleby and 10% from Spilsby, the others were mostly from surrounding villages. This is a good cross-section of the general local community
- 77% of respondents had used the Parish Rooms in the last 2 years (pre Covid) and 40% use other Village Halls which shows a good use of community assets

The main priorities for change were (in order):

- Improved parking
- Increased floor space
- Improved toilets
- Improved heating
- Improved disabled facilities
- Provide internet access
- Improved kitchen facilities
- Increase the number of electrical points
- Improve equipment
- Improved storage

Of the 28 group activities requesting consideration, 22 had between 10 and 39 interested in attending

The main functions that people would attend were (in order):

- Family events
- Adult parties
- Fundraising activities
- Children's parties

43 people offered to help the refubishment in some way

17 ideas were put forward for fundraising

In the final comments section

- 8 people suggested no change to the Parish Rooms was required
- 3 people suggested that the character of the Parish Rooms should be retained
- 5 people suggested that internal space needed to be increased
- 4 people suggested disability access should be improved
- 4 people suggested changing the internal layout
- 4 people suggested improving facilities
- 4 people suggested a new build
- 3 people suggested retaining the character of the Parish Rooms
- 3 people suggested improving communication
