- 7 Agreed Lynette to ask Kirk for a list of suitable structural engineers.
- 8 Agreed Ruth to contact Structural Engineers for costs.

- Agreed to update the community by way of social media and an informal newsletter no longer than 2 sides of A4. Jenny to write, Natalie to design and Philip to print it. All to deliver.
- 10 Lynette, Jenny, Philip to complete benchmarking form from Kirk.
- 11 Agreed Lynette and Jenny to review PRWP Terms of Reference (TOR) and take it to January Parish Council.
- All recommendations from PRWP go to the full Parish Council. Agreed the need to ensure Notes and supporting documents are placed in the public domain. Lynette to progress with The Clerk.

Concluded a positive meeting with ongoing concerns about workloads, funding, timescales and viability of plans. Heartened by the interest and positive feedback we are generating from community events. It is our responsibility, wish and will to do the absolute best we can to preserve and grow the Parish Rooms for the future.
