Welcome to this Summer edition !



In this summer newsletter, we're excited to share some important updates and upcoming events that celebrate our community spirit. Here's what's happening and how busy the PRWP have been behind the scenes - thank you !:

- Two major funding bids have been submitted – one to ELDC Grass Roots Funding and another to the National Lottery to support essential improvements to the Parish Rooms, including roof repairs, better accessibility, improved layout, and storage.
- The aim is to raise £100,000 and local fundraising events are being planned, see on the next page how YOU can help !
- Church Lane is due for resurfacing in July, with the drainage channel being replaced by a flatter, safer version.
- We're working with Spilsby Town Council to set up a Speed Watch scheme, helping to keep our roads safe. Thank you to those who have already volunteered and it's still open for anyone to get involved. Please contact the Parish Clerk.
