Present :-

Apologies were received from – Cllr Ruth Birkin, David Stonehouse, Jane Slaymaker, Elena Fraser-Green.

Farm Trip- profit £297.50 and a donation of £251 was received from a private sponsor.

Update

Ian said that the project was on target financially to finish the kitchen. There was potential for doing the rear extension. There are two windows on the plan, one for each toilet, and the flashing need to be done. This will cost an estimated £16-17K

£3039 – to finish the kitchen

£2500- for the plastering

£5539 + VAT for the building work from Marshalls

£6937 + VAT to finish the back section including the windows

There is the flooring to pay for, which is £1400 including VAT

In the funds are £28K including the Precept.

There will be £500 for the electrical work.

Cllr Grover (ELDC) is making a grant of £500, Lynette has already completed the grant application form.

If was agreed that there was enough money in the funds to complete the extension.

Philip said that the scaffolding needs to come down and Ian said that he had been chasing the builders to have it removed. He had tried to contact the scaffold company directly however he was not sure who the company were.

ACTION- Ian to contact the builders to instruct them to continue with the work as there is sufficient funds.

Yard Sale

The details for serving refreshments were agreed. Lynette to do bacon baps if feasible.

Kitchen

Lynette has told Top of the Pile that the kitchen is ready for the flooring. She is to order the stainless steel splash back as the one already purchased is not right.

The hatch is still needed however it has been put on hold. Ian said that he has a contact for the hatch shuttering so may be able to get a good price.

Lynette said that some white paint will be needed.

ACTION- Bonny to contact Hews Gray to source some paint at cost or donation.

Pop up Pub

Lynette said that Dave Birkin will organise which drinks are needed. Lynette has already applied for the licence (TEN). She had been to East Keal Pop up Pub and they have a 'sum-up' machine to take card payments. A percentage of the payment is taken when used however it is a small amount. Ian said that he has 2 beer machine which he could loan.

ACTION- Lynette to ask Natalie Tilsley to take the curtains down in the Parish Rooms for cleaning.
